The Message of 2ND **THIEF**[™]

It was the 2nd Thief's humble recognition of his justly condemned state that enabled him to receive this revelation. The standard is not how good we are compared to other people, but how do we compare to a Holy God. All fall short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23).

The "2nd Thief" turned away from his dead life to the hope of a new life. By a simple act of faith, believing that Jesus is the Son of God and then verbally acknowledging Him as his Savior, he was redeemed.

He became righteous (had right standing) with God the Father by his relationship with His Son Jesus. Faith in Christ alone, not his works.
